### F.O.P. LICENSE PLATE REGISTRATION INFORMATION

The following guidelines need to be followed in order to obtain FOP plates from the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Services and the New Jersey Fraternal Order of Police. The applications can be obtained from your lodge secretary.

1. A letter from your lodge on your lodge letterhead stating you are a member in good standing signed by a lodge officer.
2. An actual size copy of your current registration.
  - a. Registration cannot expire the month of or the following month of the application.
  - b. No commercial vehicles or motorcycles.
  - c. No temporary registrations.
  - d. Registration can be in the spouse's name.
  - e. Children of driving age living in the same household are also eligible.
  - f. Vehicles may be leased.
3. Include a photocopy of your membership card.
4. A check for sixty (\$60.00) made out to "NJ State FOP".
5. Complete all sections of the application, but **do not sign** where it says "**Signature of Organization Liaison**". Send in the original and not a photo copy.

If you answered "yes" to question 3, you may apply 2 years after the date your privilege was restored.
